The Walk: A level open walk of 2.7 miles. One highish stile which you can just squeeze past. Boots recommended due to long grass and some rough surfaces. Not suitable for buggies.

The Venue: The Plough Inn is a very popular village local serving Badger ales and home cooked food from 12:00 to 15:00. Sunday roasts start from £10. Booking is strongly advised by phone only: 01293 524292. See their old Facebook page www.facebook.com/ThePloughInn2016 for more details. The nearby Royal Oak in Ifield Green also does food.

The pub has no carpark, but there is unlimited parking 50 yards away in Rusper Road. There is also a small car park in the road behind the pub, and some parking in Rectory Lane.



OS Grid Reference: TQ 247 376.

Directions:

From A23: Take the roundabout turn off into Ifield Avenue. After 100 yards turn left into Ifield Drive. After 0.75 miles turn right at mini roundabout into Rudgwick Road. Soon turn right into Rusper Road. After 600 yards turn left into Ifield Street.

Note: We recommend the unlimited parking in Rusper Road.

Public Transport: The nearest station is 1200 yards away. Ifield is on the line between Redhill and Horley. Trains from London via Redhill arrive hourly at xx:15. See www.nationalrail.co.uk. From the station head north along Ifield Drive. After 500 yards turn left at mini roundabout into Rudgwick Road. Soon turn right into Rusper Road. After 600 yards turn left into Ifield Street.
