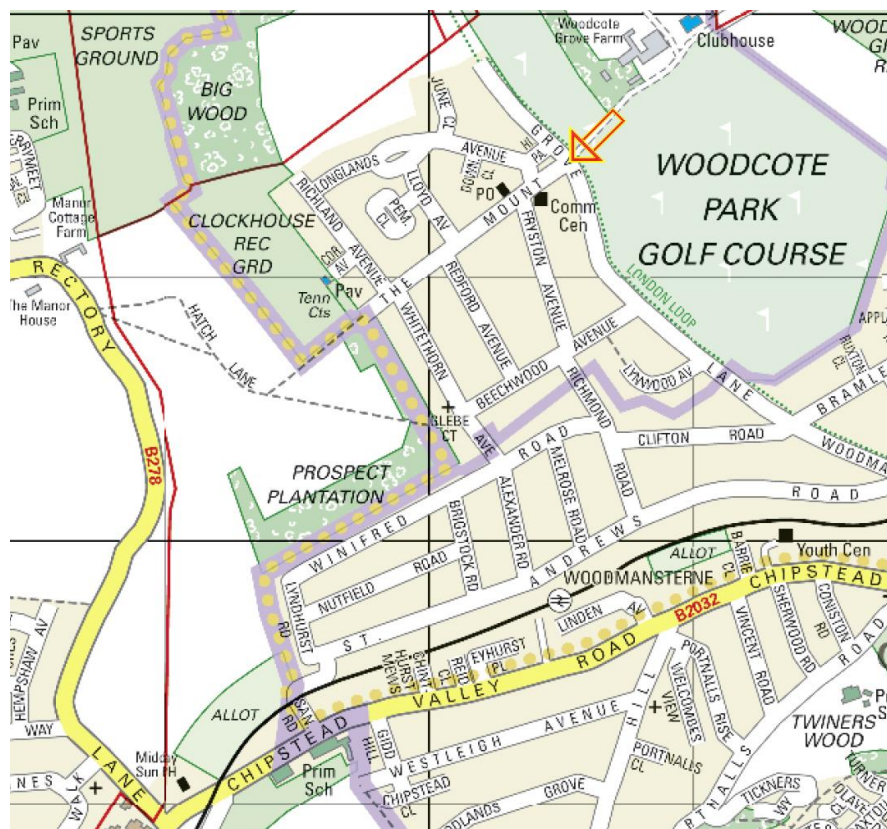

**The Walk:** This undulating 3.5 mile route is mostly on footpaths and quiet roads. It takes in a section of the London Loop and passes through Oaks Park with its café. No stiles. Not recommended for buggies.

**The Venue:** The Jack and Jill pub is closed at present and is expected to remain so during the timeframe set for this quizwalk. Park in the roads adjacent to the small green opposite the pub.



**Directions:** From the five-way roundabout at Tadworth take exit signposted Coulston A2032. At 0.5 miles (end of Bonsor Drive) turn right over railway bridge. At 2.3 miles under railway bridge. At 3.7 miles under second railway bridge. At 3.8 miles turn left off A2032 into Sandown Road. Very soon at T junction turn right (St Andrew's Road). Now take second left (Alexander Road). At X roads keep ahead into Whitethorn Avenue. At next cross roads turn right (The Mount). At 4.8 miles reach green opposite pub.

**Public Transport:** The nearest railway station is Woodmansterne. Check train times at website [www.nationalrail.co.uk](http://www.nationalrail.co.uk) From platform climb steps to bridge and turn right to road in front. Cross diagonally left and head up Alexander Road opposite. At X roads ahead into Whitethorn Avenue. At next cross roads turn right (The Mount). Continue to green opposite the Jack and Jill pub. (Distance walked 0.7 miles)

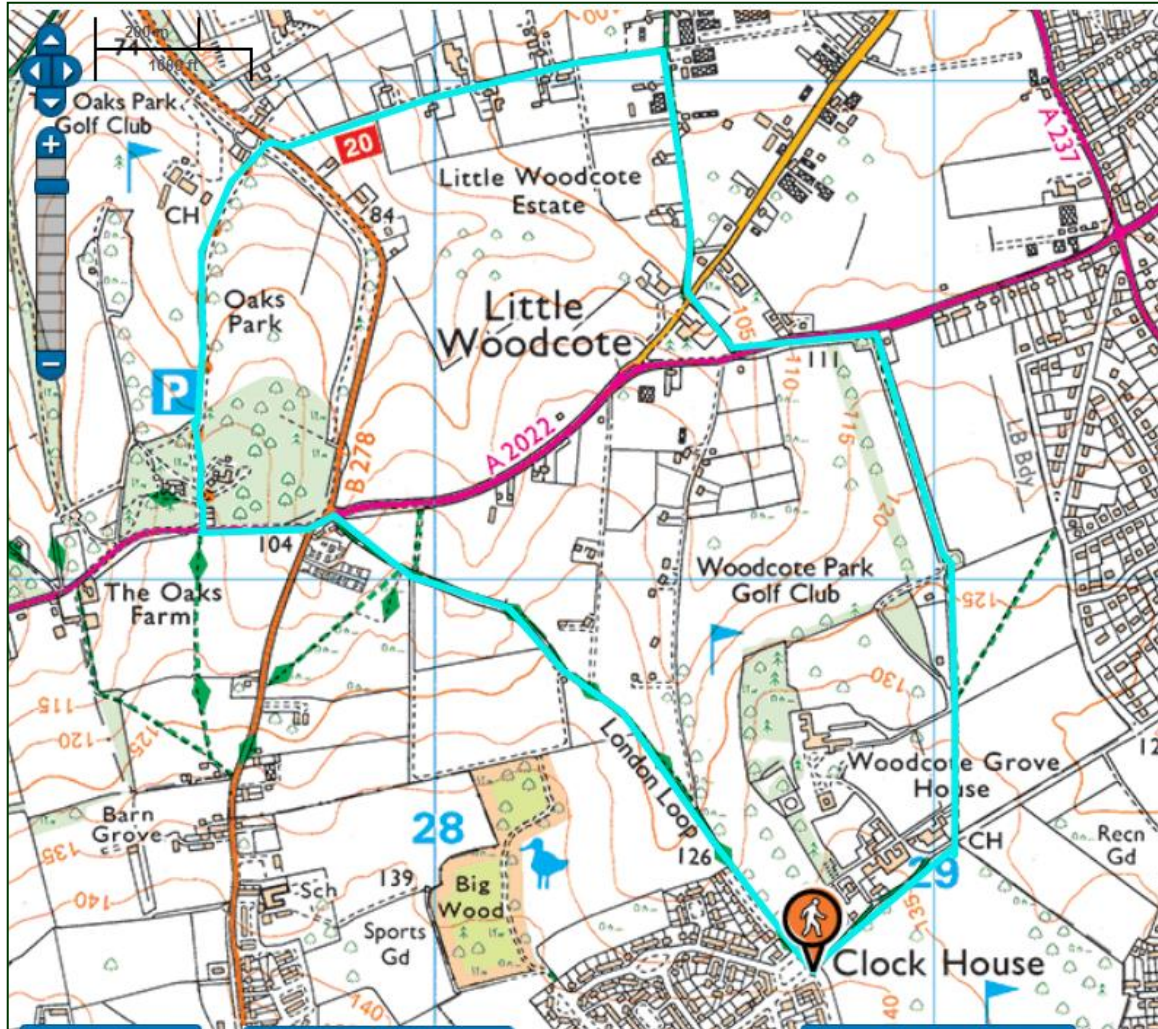
There is a 463 bus stop in The Mount opposite the pub. Service runs between Coulston South and Pollards Hill. Check bus times at <https://tfl.gov.uk/modes/buses/>

**Starter Clues**

(All the answers are visible looking in any direction when traversing the diagonal concrete path that runs across the green opposite the pub.)

**Q1 The nursery rhyme tells the tale  
Of two that went to fetch the pail.**

Q1 Didn't have a happy ending.  
In A&E they needed tending?

Q2 Unlucky for sum?

Q3 If they fail to pull their weight  
Then lost in space will be our fate.

YOU MUST ALSO ATTEMPT TO ANSWER SPARE CLUES Q26 AND Q27 BELOW.  
THEY ARE VISIBLE IN THE SAME SEARCH AREA AS CLUES Q1, Q2 AND Q3 ABOVE.

Q26 Menu choices here to spy,  
Delivered from the sky?

Q27 Correct display  
Twice a day.

**Stage 1**

As if leaving pub car park on foot turn left and immediately cross road in front to "Grove Lane" sign opposite. Left along pavement. Soon keep ahead along stony path on "Public Bridleway Croydon Lane". At fork keep left on "London Loop". Continue to point where two big metal poles are either side of path. Ahead on path, ignoring track to right. Shortly end stage at two more metal poles next to five barred gate.

**Q2 On house on left to sight,  
About to launch into flight.**

Q4 A2 05 A4 06

Q5 Threesome comes into view.  
Isn't complete without you.

## Stage 2

Ahead between poles. On reaching two-way signpost keep straight on, ignoring track to right. Very soon continue ahead along "Public Bridleway Croydon Lane". Soon descend path and proceed to main road ahead. Left and follow pavement with red brick wall on left until road joins from left.

**Q3 Just look out for "Prow".  
Record two numbers now.**

Q6 Something here has gone,  
Dropping a water bomb?

Q7 Traffic jam.

Q8 Lament by Eve  
Or departed Steve?

## Stage 3

Cross over road and head up path beside main road towards "Oaks Park". Soon cross main road at pedestrian lights. Ahead through iron gate into park. Veer left along path following "London Loop" pointer to a second one on right. After a few more yards bear right to tarmac roadway close by. Ahead past café on right. Very soon take second roadway on right, walking over a ramp. Follow roadway gently downhill. On entering car parking area stay on wide tarmac pathway until eventually passing under height barrier some way ahead.

**Q4 How many bikes can be parked here?**

Q9 To the other side  
On foot or astride.

Q10 The sexes are in sight,  
Shown just here in white.

Q11 Does this explain  
His outsize brain?

## Stage 4

Ahead to main road. Right for a few yards then cross main road and turn right to nearby side road. Left up here ("Oaks Track"). When road eventually levels out end stage on reaching white-painted metal barrier across roadway.

**Q5 For camel to display?  
Here used another way.**

Q12 Begging on either side?  
Don't they have any pride!

Q13 .....on barbed wire, say?

Q14 I spy transparency.

## Stage 5

Ahead to cross roads. Right here along "Bridleway Woodmansterne Lane". Follow concreted roadway to main road some way ahead.

**Q6 Draw for me the smiley chap  
On gate-post wearing jaunty cap.**

Q15 Point of no return!

Q16 Did she clean in these all day  
And then was cheated of her pay?

Q17 Eight wait state.

## Stage 6

From right-hand side of roadway cross main road to pointer post opposite. Ahead on path in front, passing close beside house on right. At fast main road look carefully before crossing diagonally left. Now continue up track with main road over to left. End stage at gateway to "New Lodge Farm" on right.

**Q7 Big map to be found.  
What does it take you around?**

Q18 Following queue half a dozen long?

Q19 It's inland for goodness sake.  
The esplanade must be a fake.

## Stage 7 (No answers on underlined section)

Turn right and walk up the long driveway. At top proceed to metal kiss-gate in front. Through kiss-gate and ahead along edge of field. At corner clamber over or through wooden fence in front into next field and keep straight ahead along edge to corner. Here go through second metal kiss-gate and continue on enclosed track in front. End stage at metal gate on left where track veers right.

**Q8 At kiss-gate it's quite plain.  
What is the maker's name?**

Q20 Always do it in pen.  
Ready to send out then.

Q21 The stagger is seen to stop  
When climbing to the top.

Q22 Stockings by another name,  
As worn by intellectual dame?

## Stage 8

Ignore sweep of track to right and keep ahead on narrow path between fences until reaching road at right angles. Cross straight over then turn right along pavement and pass golf clubhouse over to right. On reaching car park keep ahead on concrete pathway marked "Bridleway Grove Lane". Stay on this until reaching "Grove Lane" sign at main road.

**Q9 At red box easily seen  
Write down initials of Queen.**

Q23 Is liquid gold getting  
A very hard setting?

Q24 Five word instruction is there,  
Ignored by nearby pair.

Q25 Apart like this they stand.  
No compromise is planned.

### Important Notes

- 1) Under the social distancing rules at the time of writing (1<sup>st</sup> June) people living as a household under the same roof can form a quizwalk team with no restrictions on numbers. However, a mixed household team is limited to six people but they can come from as many as six different households. This should give our members all the flexibility they need go round with their regular team members. But remember: each household should travel separately to the Jack & Jill pub and then maintain two metre social distancing from the other households in their team. - 2) Phone our landline 01737 352832 to give us your answers so that, as is the standard procedure, we are able as organisers to ask you to clarify your answers if we think it necessary to do so. **Kindly phone as soon as you have completed the route so that things are fresh in your mind if we ask you to clarify something.**
- 3) If we are out when you phone our landline then leave a message on our mobile 07711 651727 and we will get back to you very soon. We cannot accept your answers if you phone us after the 30<sup>th</sup> June closing date.
- 4) As soon as the closing date has passed we will re-walk the route to check whether the answers to questions 1 to 25 are still there. For any missing clue(s) we will substitute instead your answer(s), if any, for such of spare clues 26 and/or 27 as are not themselves missing. If the substitution process becomes exhausted, any further clue(s) missing from the original 25 will result in the answer set being reduced to 24 clues and so on down.
- 5) Given the extended period over which participation in this quizwalk is taking place it is possible that one or more clues may have disappeared during that period such that they were solvable by teams who went round beforehand but not by those who went round afterwards. This is unfortunate but to ensure a level playing field the clue or clues in question will be subjected to the substitution process set out in 4) above.

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## Answers

- Q1 "Jack & Jill" – on wall of pub.
- Q2 "463" – on "Bus Stop" sign.
- Q3 "Earth Anchors Ltd" – on seat about halfway along concrete path.
- Q4 "London Loop" (A205 South Circular, A406 North Circular) – on disk on signpost.
- Q5 "IAE" (remaining vowels are Y O U) – on sticker on metal gate on right.
- Q6 Concrete face-plate with plate missing, possibly H (Hydrant) plate – to left of path.
- Q7 "Cars-halt-on Road" – on wooden signpost.
- Q8 Pine-apple – on brick wall at end of Stage 2.
- Q9 Pedestrians and equestrians push button road crossing – just before entering "Oaks Park".
- Q10 White painted outlines of man and woman – next to "Toilets" sign on wall of café.
- Q11 "Max Headroom 2.0M" – on overhead barrier at end of Stage 3.
- Q12 Two stone lions sitting upright – in porch of house "N2" on left at start of Stage 4.
- Q13 "Sheep Grazing" – on notice on tree near start of "Oaks Track".
- Q14 Transparent I shape – in left-side upright supporting white-painted barrier at end of Stage 4.
- Q15 "Ace" – on burglar alarm on wall of wood-framed house on right.
- Q16 "Char-con Buildings" – on large hangar-like building on left.
- Q17 "Stop" on octagon shape – on pole on left just before main road.
- Q18 "P5" – on lamppost on right.
- Q19 "Sutton C'side Walk" – on signpost near end of Stage 6.
- Q20 Sign-post – on right of field soon after passing through first metal kiss-gate.
- Q21 Metal rungs on either side of telegraph pole converging near top – behind hedgerow on right.
- Q22 Blue hose – at trough on left.
- Q23 Oil drum filled with concrete – supporting gate located immediately after crossing over road.
- Q24 "Horse riders please keep right" and signpost just beyond with image of horse and rider going to the left – on signage at start of "Bridleway Grove Lane".
- Q25 Metal poles spaced out across pathway (cf the phrase *poles apart*) – at end of Stage 8.
- Q26 Satellite dishes – on pub building.
- Q27 Clock stopped just before eight – on wall of flats above parade of shops.

## Young Walkers' Answers

- Q1 "Jack & Jill" – on wall of pub.
- Q2 Cream-painted eagle about to take flight – on wall of house No 119 near start of Stage 1.
- Q3 "Prow 87" or "Prow 89" – on two-way signpost.
- Q4 Three bike-parking stations – in front of café.
- Q5 "Hump" – on signage near ramp in road.
- Q6 Smiling image of boy wearing a cap – on gate-post of house on left near start of Stage 5.
- Q7 "Discover Little Woodcote Wood" – on large map at start of narrow path.
- Q8 "Centrewire" – on name-plate on metal kiss-gate.
- Q9 "EIRR" – on red post-box on left just before start of "Bridleway Grove Lane".

**Scoring:** Ten points for each correct answer given to questions 1 to 9 above.

**I –SPY** question - one point for each valid word, up to a maximum of 40 words.
