The Walk:

A 2.9 mile walk from this traditional pub in the pretty Kent village of Shoreham. The route is mostly on quiet roads and lanes, with gentle terrain and no stiles.

The Venue:

The Crown is a traditional pub serving Sunday lunch and a range of other mains. Food is served 12:00-16:00 on Sundays but **not Sunday evenings**. It remains open for drinks and snacks on Sunday evenings, and has a garden. Parking is on surrounding roads.

If booking for lunch, please mention that you are coming for the Quiz Walk as the manager said she might open an overflow room and seat all the Quiz Walkers together if there are enough.

Directions:

From M25: Exit J4 and take spur (first left) to Hewitts Roundabout. Take first left onto A224, then through Badgers Mount. At next roundabout, take first left into Shacklands Road. After 1½ mi, turn right into High Street. After sharp right bend into village, pub is on the left after another 100 yds.

Public Transport:

Shoreham station is served by Thameslink from London Blackfriars (via Bromley South), half-hourly on Sundays. No engineering works scheduled for this route on 3rd July. The pub is ¾ mi from the station. Orpington and Sevenoaks stations are the closest large stations, but will require a taxi.
